

INTERNATIONAL GRADUATE STUDENT APPLICATION, ADMISSION AND REGISTRATION REQUIREMENTS

A. WHO CAN APPLY?

1. Candidates who are foreign nationals (non-Turkish citizens) with at least bachelor's degree (for master's program applications) / master's degree (for doctoral program applications),
2. Candidates who are citizens of the Republic of Turkey and have completed their undergraduate education at a higher education institution abroad and have at least a bachelor's degree (for master's program applications) / master's degree (for doctoral program applications),
3. Candidates who have dual citizenship and have completed their undergraduate education at a higher education institution abroad and have at least a bachelor's degree (for master's program applications) / master's degree (for doctoral program applications), can apply.

B. WHO CANNOT APPLY?

1. Turkish citizens who have completed part or all of their undergraduate (for master's program applications) / master's (for doctoral program applications) education at a higher education institution located in the Republic of Turkey and/or the Turkish Republic of Northern Cyprus,
2. Citizens of the Turkish Republic of Northern Cyprus who have completed part or all of their undergraduate (for master's program applications) / master's (for doctoral program applications) education at a higher education institution in the Republic of Turkey and/or the Turkish Republic of Northern Cyprus, cannot apply.

C. APPLICATION CONDITIONS?

1. To have at least a bachelor's degree (for master's program applications) / master's degree (for doctoral program applications) recognized as equivalent by the Council of Higher Education (YÖK) of the Republic of Turkey,
2. Graduating from any higher education institution abroad, the equivalence of which has not yet been accepted by the Council of Higher Education (YÖK), with at least a bachelor's degree (for master's program applications) / master's degree (for doctoral program applications) and providing the diploma equivalence of the relevant institution until the maximum period of time,

NOTE: Candidates who have graduated from an abroad higher education institution and whose diploma equivalency has not yet been accepted by the Council of Higher Education (YÖK) at the time of application will be given temporary registration, and their student procedures will be initiated.

NOTE: Candidates can apply to a maximum of two different graduate programs from the announced quotas.

NOTE: Candidates are required to apply with their current and valid email addresses when applying.

2. Scanned PDF of the passport information page
3. Turkish Language Exam Certificate (Turkish Proficiency Exam Certificate) or a scanned PDF of this document **(if available)**
4. Bachelor's Degree Graduation Certificate or a scanned PDF of this document (for Master's Program applications)
5. Master's Degree Graduation Certificate or a scanned PDF of this document (for Doctoral Program applications)
6. Bachelor's Degree Transcripts or a scanned PDF of these documents (for Master's Program applications)
7. Master's Degree Transcripts or a scanned PDF of these documents (for Doctoral Program applications)
8. For candidates who graduated from universities abroad, the Diploma Equivalency Certificate from the Council of Higher Education (YÖK) or scanned PDF of this document **(if any)**,
9. For PhD applications, a foreign language proficiency certificate recognized as equivalent by YÖK or a scanned PDF of this document **(if available)**,
10. Receipt of the \$50 material fee or a scanned PDF of this document,

NOTE: All documents submitted by the candidate must be accompanied by a Turkish translation approved by a notary or the Turkish Republic's Foreign Representative Offices. Otherwise, the document will be considered invalid.

E. EVALUATION CRITERIA

1. In the evaluation of applications of foreign candidates to graduate programs where the language of instruction is Turkish, candidates are included in the ranking of the relevant program by taking into account 70% of their undergraduate graduation grade for master's programs, 70% of their master's graduation grade for doctoral programs, and 30% of their Turkish language/proficiency exam grade. Candidates who do not have a Turkish proficiency certificate accepted by the relevant institute's board of directors will have their Turkish language/proficiency exam score considered as 0 (zero) in the ranking.

2. Applications of the candidates applying to graduate programs are evaluated based on the success score formed according to the principles outlined in the above (Article 1), and candidates are ranked from highest to lowest according to their success scores, as determined by the institute board within the specified quota. Candidates are determined as primary and reserve based on their success scores.

F. OTHER MATTERS

1. For the admission of foreign students to postgraduate programs, ALES and Foreign Language scores are not required.
2. The Turkish Language Exam (Turkish Proficiency Exam) is conducted by a three-member jury appointed by the Institute Administrative Board or by a unit it deems appropriate. To be considered successful in this exam and to be able to start classes, it is required to score at least 70 out of 100. Students who fail the exam are granted a one-year leave to learn Turkish. Students who do not pass the Turkish language exam, which will be conducted in the same manner within 1 year, will have their affiliation with the institute terminated. Candidates who possess a Turkish language proficiency certificate accepted by the relevant institute's board of directors are exempt from the Turkish language exam.
3. Candidates applying for doctoral programs must possess a master's degree recognized as equivalent by YÖK in the relevant department.
4. The registration of foreign students who are granted the right to enroll is carried out at the relevant institute, and their student affairs are initiated. These students are required to submit the equivalency documents of the higher education institution they graduated from to YÖK until their graduation. Otherwise, the students' graduation procedures will not be carried out, and at the end of the maximum period, their affiliation with our institute will be terminated.
5. If the documents specified in the conditions are incomplete, the application will not be evaluated.
6. Candidates who have not entered the Republic of Turkey through legal means or do not have the right to stay legally will not be registered, even if they have been placed in any department.

G. CONDITIONS FOR FINAL REGISTRATION

Students who have been granted the right to enroll in our institute's graduate programs must send the following documents, in addition to the required documents for the application, to our institute's email address bayu_lisansustu@bayburt.edu.tr.

1. A wet-signed copy of the final registration document or a colour scanned PDF of this document,
2. Foreign students who have the right to final registration must pay the tuition fee, and after learning the tuition fee from the website <https://bayburt.edu.tr/tr/harc-hizmetleri>, they must submit the tuition payment receipt or the scanned PDF of this document,

Note: The email address mentioned above is only for applications. If documents are sent to any address other than this email address, the final registration process will not be completed.

H. THINGS TO DO AFTER FINAL REGISTRATION

1. Foreign students, upon request, must pay the **General Health Insurance Premium Fee** of the Social Security Institution for the Fall Semester of the 2025-2026 Academic Year to the account number that will be specified later.
2. Students who complete their registration must inform the institute of their temporary **Foreign National Citizen T.C. number** by the end of the registration period.
3. Students who complete their registration must submit a certified photocopy of the residence permit obtained from the Provincial Directorate of Migration Management to the Institute Directorate by the end of the registration period.
